As you may have heard, the Gardens are due to close in mid-November to enable the major restoration works to be carried out. As all the paths will be dug up and re-laid with resin-bonded gravel, this is the most cost-effective and safest course of action.

As soon as the contractors are appointed we will begin discussions with them about whether it is possible to keep any part of the Gardens open, while work continues in another part, but health and safety issues may mean this is not possible.

However, it will be part of the brief for the contractors to keep us all up to date with their progress and so regular updates will be available through the new website, which will be up and running soon.


The contractors will also organise open days so that park users can come in and see what is being done and how the Gardens are being restored.
