Protecting our plants and bulbs

Paths

We are really pleased to report that the Council has agreed to proceed with legal action about the paths. Their poor state following so shortly after £400,000 of investment is extremely concerning. A recent survey undertaken by the Friends in preparation for the case identified more than 100 significant cracks across the surface and higher numbers of problems with the path edges.


